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# The Larger Catechism

## THE LAW'S TRANSGRESSION AND PENALTY

**Question 151: What are the circumstances that make some sins more sinful than others?**

**Answer: (continued)**

**4. Circumstance of time and place: Sins are rendered more sinful if on the Lord's Day or other times of divine worship, or immediately before or after these or other helps to prevent or remedy such misdeeds; if in public in the presence of others likely to be provoked or led into sin because of them.**

**Question 152: What does every sin deserve at the hands of God?**

**Answer: Every sin, even the least, is against the sovereignty, goodness and holiness of God, and against His righteous law, and therefore deserves His wrath and curse both in this life and the life that is to come. The penalty for sin cannot be paid except by the blood of Christ.**

## THE WAY TO BE SAVED

**Question 153: What does God require of us that we may escape His wrath and curse due to us for the transgressions of the law?**

**Answer: To escape the wrath and curse due to us for the transgressions of the law, God requires of us repentance towards Himself and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ, and the diligent use of the outward means by which Christ gives us the benefits of his mediation.**

**Question 154: What are the outward means by which Christ gives us the benefits of His mediation?**

**Answer: The outward and ordinary means by which Christ gives to His church the benefits of His mediation are all His ordinances, especially the word, sacraments and prayer, and all these are made effective in the salvation of the elect.**

### The Intermediate State WCF 32:1

After death people's bodies decompose, and experience decay. But their persons immediately return to God who gave them, since they possess immortal existence, neither dying nor sleeping.

The persons of the righteous, being then perfected in holiness, are received immediately into the highest heaven, where they gaze on the face of God in light and glory, waiting for the complete redemption of their bodies.


But the persons of the wicked are thrown into hell, where they remain in torments and complete darkness, being kept alive for the judgement of the great Day.

The Scripture recognises no other places than these two, for persons separated from their bodies.

THE BIBLE AS A MEANS OF GRACE

**Question 155: How is the word of God made effective to salvation?**

*Answer: The Spirit of God makes the reading but especially the preaching of the word, an effective means of enlightening, convincing and humbling sinners; of driving them out of themselves and drawing them to Christ; of conforming them to Christ's image, and subduing them to His will; of strengthening them against temptations and corruptions; of building them up in grace, and establishing their hearts in holiness and comfort, through faith, to salvation.*


