God confiding, fruitful if in Christ abiding, holy through the Spirit's guiding; all must be well.

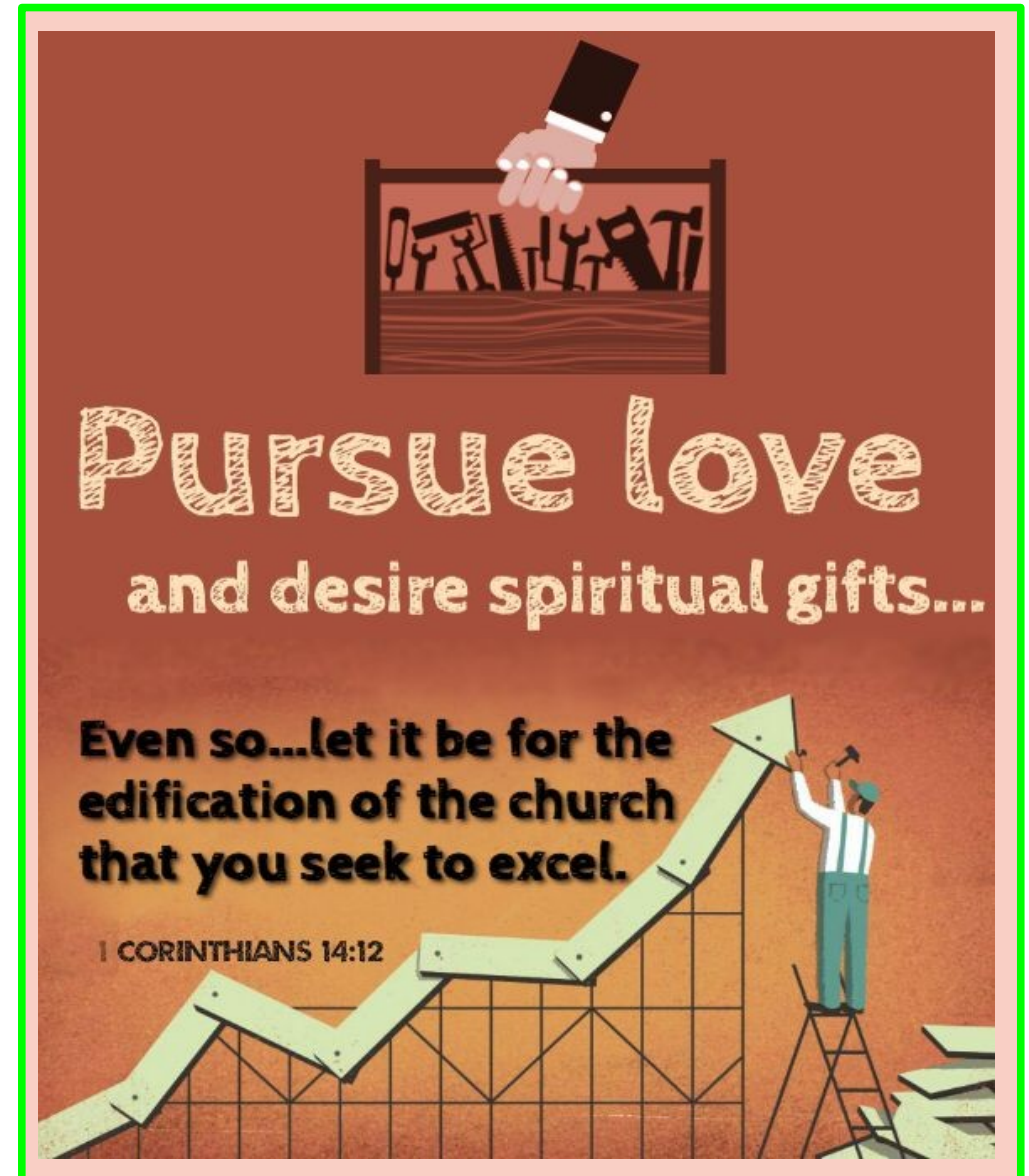

Jesus, forever with us stay, make all our moments calm and bright, chase the dark night of sin away, spread through the world Your holy light.

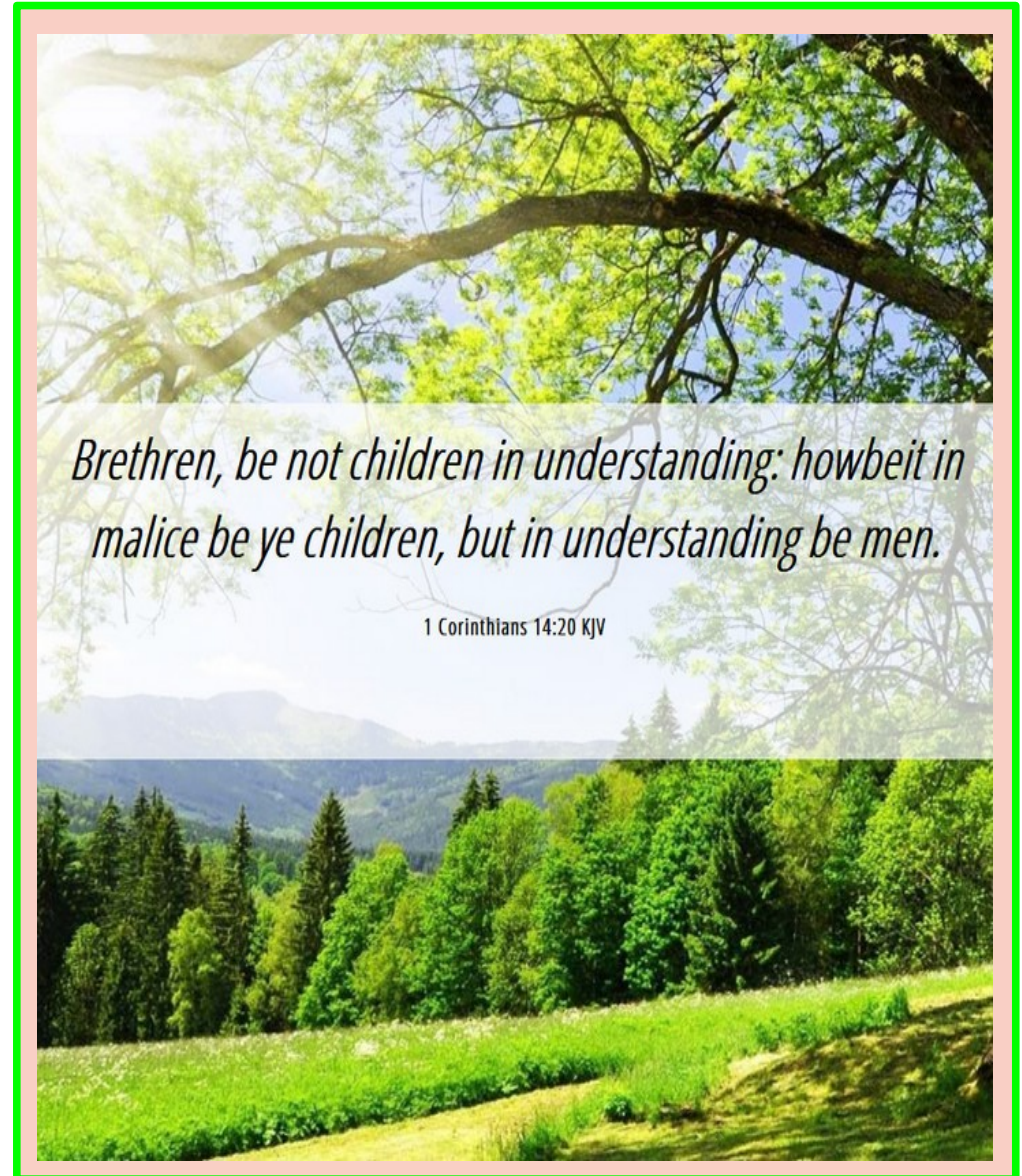
