# The Larger Catechism of the WCF

## God's Covenant of Grace [WCF 7:3-6]

Question 34: How was the covenant of grace administered under the Old Testament?

*Answer: The covenant of grace was administered under the Old Covenant by promises,<sup>1</sup> prophecies,<sup>2</sup> sacrifices,<sup>3</sup> circumcision,<sup>4</sup> the Passover,<sup>5</sup> and other types and ordinances, all of which foreshadowed Christ yet to come. They were for that time sufficient to build up the elect in faith in the promised Messiah,<sup>6</sup> by whom they had full remission of sin and eternal salvation.<sup>7</sup>*

Question 35: How was the covenant of grace administered under the New Testament?

*Answer: Under the New Testament, when Christ the substance was revealed, the same covenant of Grace was and still is to be administered in the preaching of the Word,<sup>1</sup> and the administration of the sacraments of Baptism<sup>2</sup> and the Lord's Supper.<sup>3</sup> In these grace and salvation are held forth in more fulness, clarity and spiritual power to all nations.<sup>4</sup>*

### Particular Redemption

3.6 Just as God has appointed the chosen for glory, so He has appointed beforehand all the means to it, out of the eternal and most free design of His will.<sup>1</sup> So those who are redeemed by Christ, having been fallen in Adam,<sup>2</sup> are effectively called to faith in Christ through His Spirit working in due time; they are put in the right, adopted, set apart,<sup>3</sup> and kept by His power through faith for salvation.<sup>4</sup> Only the chosen are redeemed by Christ, effectively called, put in the right, adopted, set apart and saved, and no one else.<sup>5</sup>

# The Westminster Confession of Faith

## 25: The Church

### The Hidden Church

25.1 The general or worldwide Church, which is hidden, consists of the full number of the chosen, who have been, are, or will be gathered into one, under Christ its head. It is the wife, the body, the fullness of the One who fills all in all.<sup>1</sup>

### The Outward Church

25.2 The Church that can be seen, which is also general or worldwide under the Gospel, (not restricted to a single nation, as formerly under the Law), consists of all those, across the world, who profess the true religion,<sup>1</sup> along with their children.<sup>2</sup> This is the kingdom of the Lord Jesus Christ,<sup>3</sup> the household and family of God, outside of which there is normally no possibility of salvation.<sup>4</sup>

### Christ's Gift to the Church

25.3 Christ has given to this general, outward church –

- the ministry
- the word and
- regulations

from God, for the ingathering of the saints and their maturing in this life, until the end of the age. By His own presence and Spirit, He makes these (means) effective for achieving these ends, just as He promised.<sup>1</sup>

### Tests of Purity

25.4 This general Church has sometimes been more, sometimes less apparent.<sup>1</sup> And local churches, which are members of it, are more or less pure, depending on whether –

- the doctrine of the Gospel is taught and received,
- the regulations are complied with, and
- the public worship is performed

more or less purely in them.<sup>2</sup>

### Compromise and Error

25.5 The purest churches on earth are liable to both compromise and error,<sup>1</sup> and some have so worsened that they have ceased to be churches of Christ, but rather assemblies of Satan.<sup>2</sup> None the less there will always be a church on earth to worship God as He desires.<sup>3</sup>

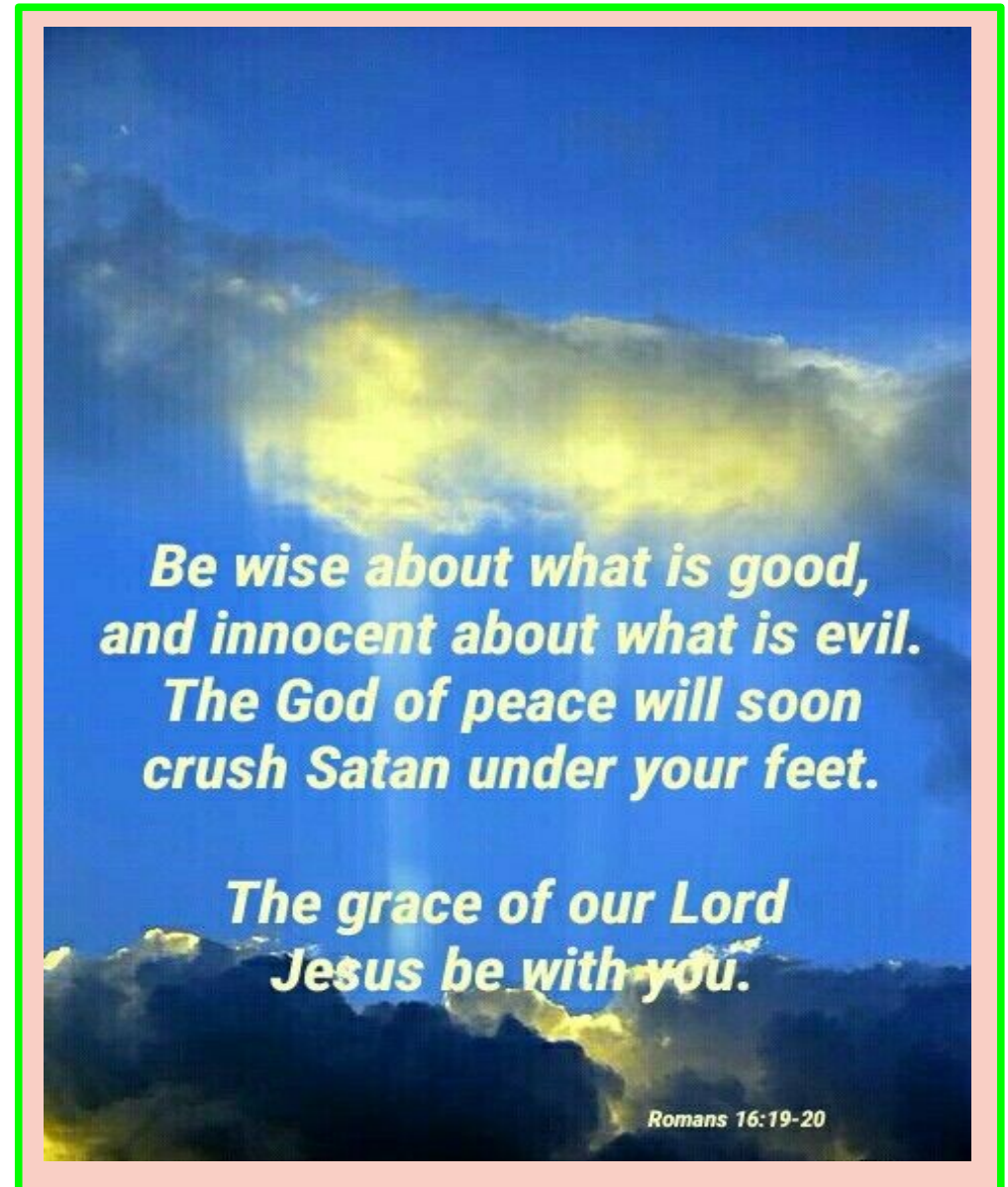

# The Westminster Confession of Faith

## 10: Effective Calling

### What Is Effective Calling?

10.1 All those and only those whom God has appointed beforehand for life, He is pleased, in His appointed and accepted time, to call effectively<sup>1</sup> by His word and Spirit,<sup>2</sup> out of that state of sin and death in which they are naturally, to grace and salvation through Jesus Christ<sup>3</sup> by –

- enlightening their minds spiritually and savingly to understand the things of God<sup>4</sup>
- taking away their hard heart and giving them a soft heart<sup>5</sup>
- renewing their wills, and by His almighty power, constraining them to what is good<sup>6</sup>
- effectively drawing them to Jesus Christ,<sup>7</sup> yet in such a way that they come most freely, being made willing by His grace.<sup>8</sup>

### Wholly Gracious

10.2 This effective call is a result of God's free and special grace only, not from anything at all foreseen in the human person,<sup>1</sup> who is altogether passive therein, until made alive and renewed by the Holy Spirit.<sup>2</sup> They are in this way empowered to answer this call, and to receive the grace offered and conveyed by it.<sup>3</sup>

### Spiritual Rebirth without Calling

10.3 Chosen children who die in childhood,<sup>1</sup> are reborn and saved by Christ through the Spirit,<sup>2</sup> who works when, where and how He pleases;<sup>3</sup> in the same way are all other chosen people who are incapable of being outwardly called by the ministry of the word.<sup>1&2</sup>

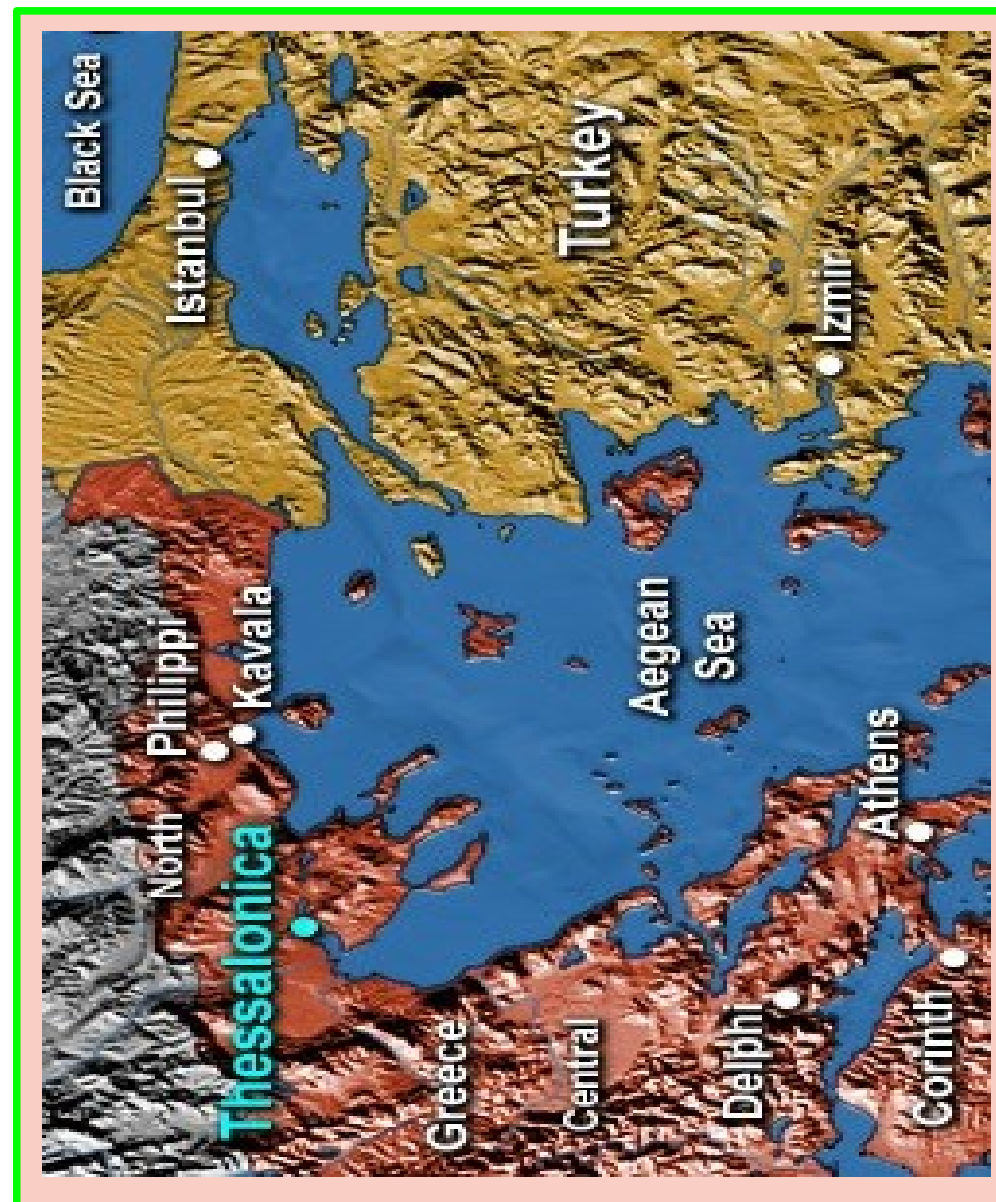

# The Westminster Confession of Faith

## 10: Effective Calling

### Indispensable for Salvation

10.4 Other people, although not chosen, may be called by the ministry of the word,<sup>1</sup> and may experience some general influences of the Spirit,<sup>2</sup> yet never truly come to Christ, and so cannot be saved.<sup>3</sup> Much less can people not professing the christian religion be saved in any other way whatever, however diligent they may be in ordering their lives in accordance with the light of nature and the law of that religion they profess.<sup>4</sup> To assert and maintain that they may is very dangerous and detestable.<sup>5</sup>

## 26: Christian Fellowship

### Communion in Faith and Love

26.1 All those who have been set apart are united, by His Spirit and by faith, to Jesus Christ their head, have communion with Him in His graces, sufferings, death, resurrection, and glory.<sup>1</sup> And they have communion in each other's gifts and graces, since they are united to one another in love.<sup>2</sup> And they are under obligation to perform those public and private responsibilities that contribute to their mutual benefit, in both the inner and outer person.<sup>3</sup>


