When Satan tempts me to despair and tells me of the guilt within, upward I look, and see Him there who put an end to all my sin.

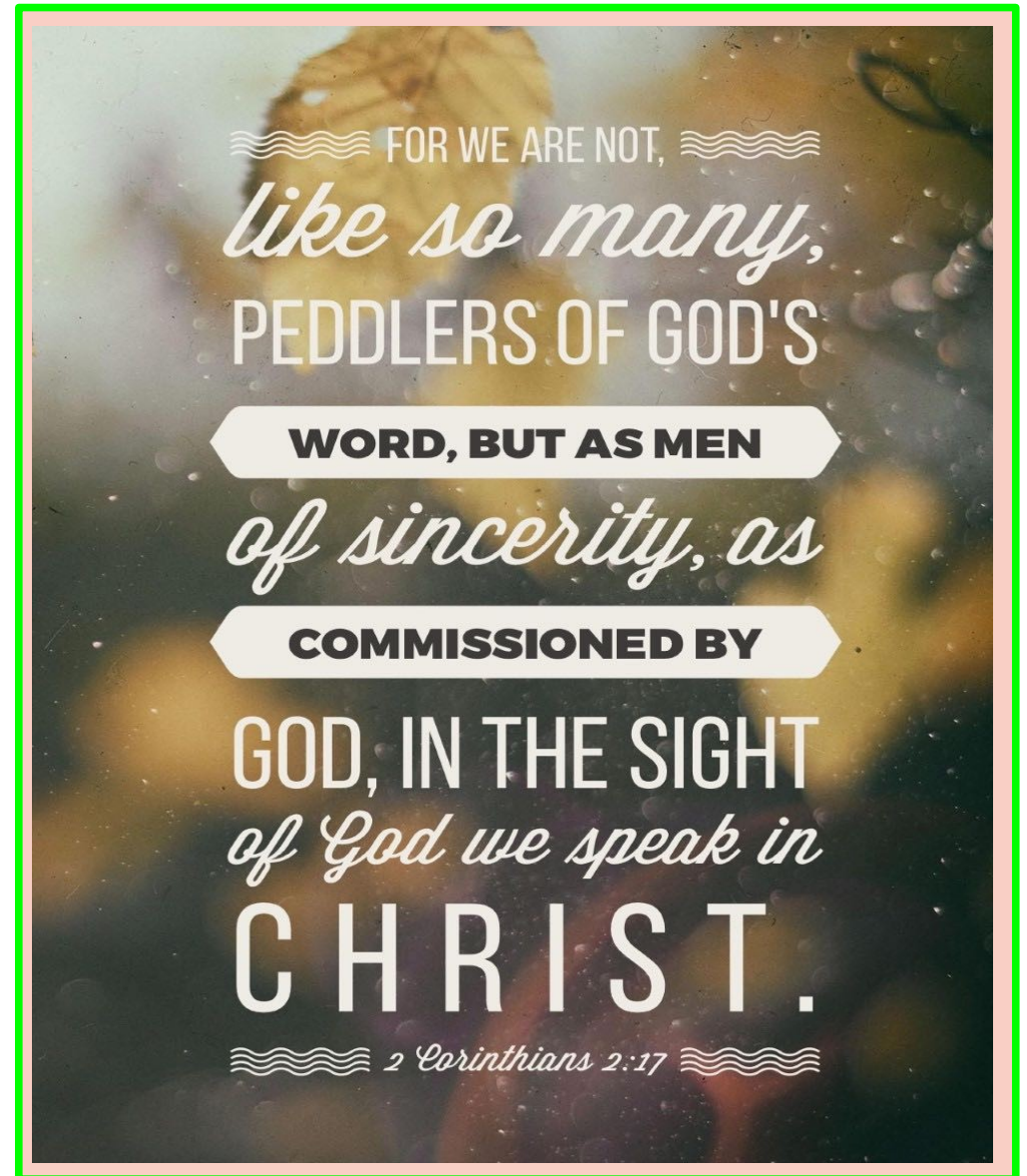
Because the sinless Saviour died, my sinful soul is counted free; for God, the Just, is satisfied to look on Him and pardon me.

Question 168: What is the Lord's Supper?

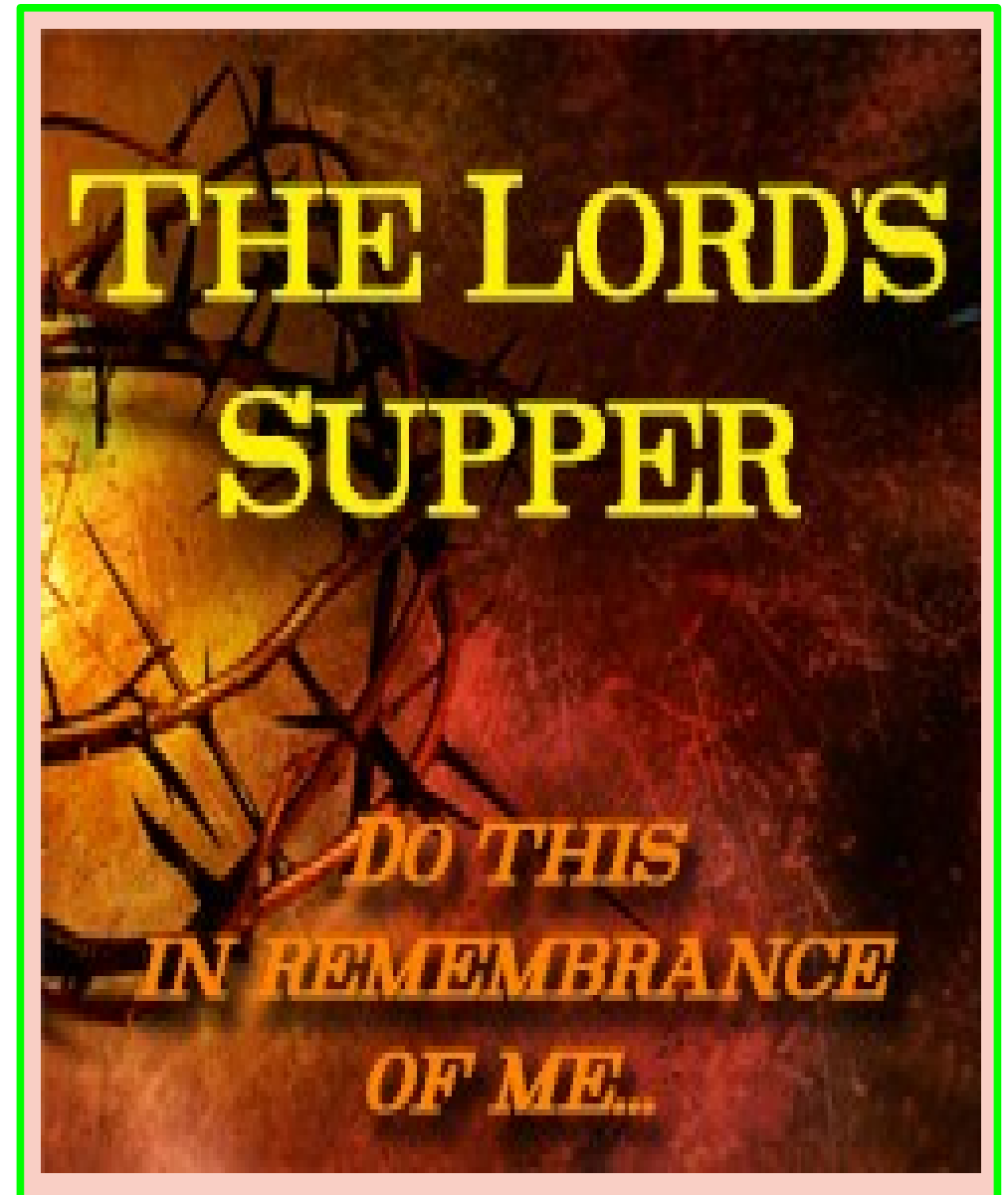



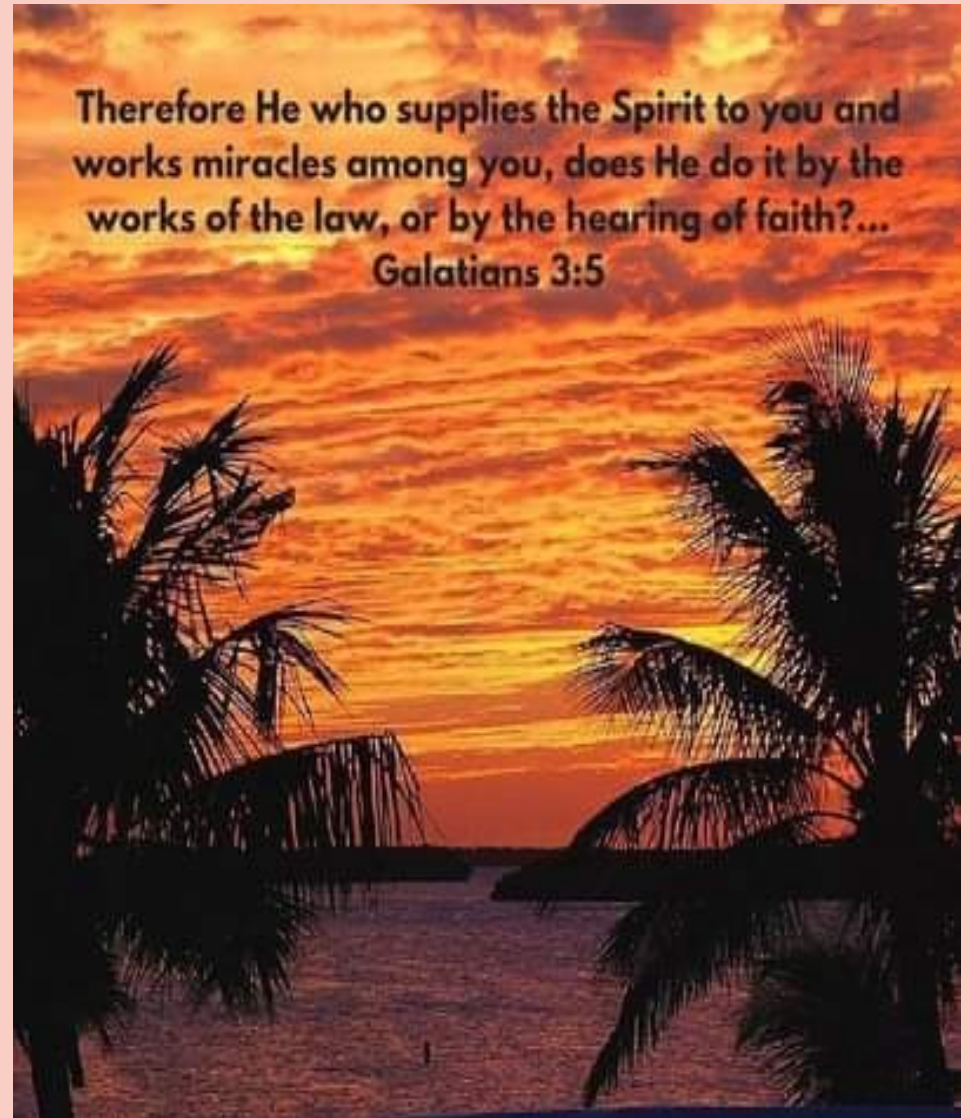
