## The Larger Catechism

### BAPTISM (WCF 28)

Question 167: How is our Baptism to be used by us to good effect?

*Answer: The necessary but much neglected duty of using our Baptism to good effect is an obligation throughout our lives, especially in temptation and when we are present at the administration of Baptism to others. Baptism is used to good effect by serious and thankful consideration of its nature, the purposes for which Christ instituted it, the privileges and benefits conferred and sealed by it, and our solemn vow made in it; by being humbled for our sinful defilement, for our falling short of and living contrary to the grace of Baptism and our pledges; by growing up to assurance of pardon of sin, and of all the other blessings sealed to us in Baptism; by drawing strength from the death and resurrection of Christ, into whom we are baptised, for the putting to death of sin and making alive in grace; and by making every effort to live by faith, to conduct ourselves in holiness and righteousness as those who in Baptism have enlisted in Christ's service, and to walk in brotherly love as being baptised by the same Spirit into one body.*

# The Larger Catechism

## THE LORD'S SUPPER (WCF 29)

**Question 169: How has Christ appointed that the bread and wine be given and received in the sacrament of the Lord's Supper?**

*Answer: Christ has appointed the ministers of His word, when administering the sacrament of the Lord's Supper, to set apart the bread and wine from common use by the word of institution, thanksgiving and prayer. They then take and break the bread, and give both the bread and the wine to the communicants, In accordance with Christ's appointment the communicants are to take and eat the bread, and to drink the wine, in thankful remembrance that the body of Christ was broken and given, and His blood shed, for them.*

**The Larger Catechism**  
**THE LORD'S SUPPER (WCF 29)**

**Question 170: How do those who receive rightly the Lord's Supper feed on the body and blood of Christ?**

*Answer: The body and blood of Christ are not physically present in, with or under the bread and wine in the Lord's Supper, and yet are spiritually present to the faith of the receiver in a way no less true and real than the elements are to their outward senses. It follows that those who rightly participate in the sacrament of the Lord's Supper do not feed on the body and blood of Christ by the mouth in a physical manner, but in a spiritual yet true and real way when by faith they receive and apply to themselves Christ crucified and all the benefits of His death.*
