The Use of the Law for the Christian

Although true believers are not under the law as a covenant of works, to be put in the right or condemned by it, yet it has great value for them as well as for others. Because, as a rule of life, informing them of the will of God and their responsibility, it directs and obliges them to live accordingly. It reveals also the sinful pollutions of their nature, hearts and lives. As a result, by examining them with it, they may –

- arrive at further conviction of sin
- be humbled because of it, and
- be filled with hatred against it, along with –
- a clearer sight of the need they have of Christ, and
- the perfection of His obedience.

Excerpts from the Westminster Confession

The Use of the Law for the Christian (continued)

It is likewise of value to the reborn, to restrain their corruptions, in that it forbids sin; and its threatenings serve to show what even their sins deserve, and what sufferings in this life they may expect for them, although freed from the curse of it, threatened in the law.

Its promises, in the same way, show them God's approval of obedience, and what blessings they may expect on keeping it, although not due to them by the law as a covenant of works. So that a person's doing good and refraining from evil, is no evidence of their being under the law, and not under grace, because the law encourages to the one and deters from the other.

Excerpts from the Westminster Confession

The Possibility of Assurance (WCF 18:1)

Nominal Christians and other people who have not been reborn, may deceive themselves in vain with false hopes and worldly assumptions that they are in God's favour and a state of salvation (this hope of theirs will fail). Yet those people who truly believe in the Lord Jesus, and love Him sincerely, aiming to live in all good conscience in His sight, may be certainly assured in this life, that they are in the state of grace, and may rejoice in hoping for the glory of God, (this hope will never disappoint them).

The Grounds of Assurance (WCF 18:2)

- the witness of the Spirit of sonship, witnessing with our spirits that we are the children of God.

Excerpts from the Westminster Confession

Loss of Assurance (WCF 18:3)

This infallible assurance does not so belong to what faith really is, that a true believer may not wait a long time and struggle with many difficulties, before they come to share in it. Yet in being enabled by the Holy Spirit to know the things which have been freely given them by God, they may, without special revelation, in the right use of normal means attain to it.

And so it is the duty of every one to make every effort to ensure their call and election, so that in this way their heart may –

- be enlarged with peace and joy in the Holy Spirit
- be filled with love and thankfulness to God, and
- in strength and cheerfulness in the duties of obedience, the natural fruits of this assurance.

So far is it from encouraging people to live carelessly.
