## The Larger Catechism

### THE LORD'S SUPPER (WCF 29)

**Question 97: (Shorter Catechism) What is required to receive rightly the Lord's Supper?**

**Answer:** *It is required of those who would receive rightly the Lord's Supper, that they examine themselves as to their knowledge of the meaning and object of this sacrament, their faith to feed upon Christ, and their repentance, love and new obedience; for coming in an unworthy manner would bring judgement on themselves.*

**Question 173: May any who profess the faith and desire to come to the Lord's Supper be kept from it?**

**Answer:** *Those who are found to be ignorant or giving offence, even though they profess the faith and desire to come to the Lord's Supper, may and ought to be kept from it by the authority which Christ has left in His church, until they receive instruction and show changed lives.*

THE LORD'S SUPPER (WCF 29)

**Question 174: When the Lord's Supper is administered, what is required of those who receive it?**

*Answer: During the time of its administration it is required of those who receive the sacrament of the Lord's Supper that they wait on God in that ordinance with all holy reverence and attention; that they diligently observe the sacramental elements and actions, carefully recognise the Lord's body, and lovingly meditate on His death and sufferings, and thus stir themselves up to a vigorous exercise of their graces. Thus they are to judge themselves, sorrow for sin, earnestly hunger and thirst after Christ, feed on Him by faith, receive of its fullness, trust in its merits, rejoice in His love, give thanks for His grace, and renew their covenant with God and their love to all the saints.*

**Question 175: What is the duty of Christians after they have received the sacrament of the Lord's Supper?**


*Answer: The duty of Christians after they have received the sacrament of the Lord's Supper, is seriously to consider how they have conducted themselves in it, and with what success. If they are strengthened and comforted, they are to bless God for it, plead for its continuance, watch against back-sliding, fulfil their vows, and encourage themselves to frequent attendance at the ordinance. But if they find no present benefit, they are to very strictly to review their preparation for, and conduct at, the sacrament. If they can approve themselves to God and their own consciences in both aspects they are to wait for the benefit of it in due time. However, if in either preparation or conduct they see they have failed, they are to be humbled, and next time to receive the sacrament with more care and diligence.*
